

## WHAT CHRIST CAME TO DO

It is a wonderful revelation of God's grace to consider what our Lord came to do coupled with His declaration on the cross - "it is finished."

### **THINK OF IT - DONE!**

Joh 5:34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.

Joh 5:36 But I have greater witness than that of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.

Joh 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is **finished**: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Here are some of the things He did, that is, that He finished for us --

Mat 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

Mat 3:12 Whose fan is in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

Mat 5:17 ¶ Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

Mat 9:13 But go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Mat 10:34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.

Mat 18:11 For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.

Mat 20:28 Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.

Lk 1:68 Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people.

Lk 1:69 And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;

Lk 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised.

Lk 5:32 I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Lk 12:49 I am come to send fire on the earth; and what will I, if it be already kindled?

Lk 19:10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

Jn 6:38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

Jn 10:16 And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd.

Jn 12:47 And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

Jn 17: 4 I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.

1 Tim 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

Heb 2:14 ¶ Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

1 Jn 4:9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

1 Jn 4:10 Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

1 Jn 4:14 ¶ And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Saviour of the world.

19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is **finished:** and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

**THIS MEANS THAT:**

1. We are **not** under the law
2. Sin will **not** have dominion over us
3. We **are** under grace, unmerited favor, not works

Romans 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

4. We are **now** redeemed from the curse of the law

Galatians 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed [is] every one that hangeth on a tree:

Galatians 4:4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,

Galatians 4: 5 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

5. We **have already** been made alive

Ephesians 2:4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,

Ephesians 2:5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

6. We are now **completely** redeemed

7. We are **now** reconciled

Ephesians 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Colossians 1:20 And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, [I say], whether [they be] things in earth, or things in heaven.

Colossians 1:21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in [your] mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled

Colossians 1:22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in his sight:

8. We are **now** sons of God

Galatians 4:5 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

Galatians 4:6 And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

9. We are **now** heirs of God

Galatians 4:7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

10. We are **now** blessed with all spiritual blessings

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed [be] the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly [places] in Christ:

11. We **are** His chosen ones

12. We **now** have peace with God

13. We **are now** holy and without blame

Ephesians 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

Colossians 1:20 And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, [I say], whether [they be] things in earth, or things in heaven.

Colossians 1:21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in [your] mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled

Colossians 1:22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in his sight:

14. We **already have** complete forgiveness of sin

Ephesians 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Colossians 1:14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, [even] the forgiveness of sins:

Colossians 2:13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

15. We are **now** complete in Him

Colossians 2:10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

16. We are **now** accepted in Christ

Ephesians 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.

17. We **have already** been perfected forever

Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

18. We **always** have the victory

I Corinthians 15:57 But thanks [be] to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

19. We are **always** caused to triumph

II Corinthians 2:14 Now thanks [be] unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

20. We have **absolute** certainty of our outcome in Christ

Philippians 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform [it] until the day of Jesus Christ:
